

Nine Hole Member

A Nine Hole Member is a person who as a result of a medical or physical condition or disability is unable to play continuously eighteen holes of golf but is able to play nine holes of golf.

An existing member of the Devonport Golf Club may at any time transfer their membership to a Nine Hole Member upon the production of a medical certificate stating that they would be incapable of continuously completing eighteen holes of golf.

A Nine Hole Membership may also be offered on a limited basis to beginners of golf to encourage their participation in the Club.

A Nine Hole Member must pay fifty (50) percent of a Full Annual Membership subscription which must be paid at the commencement of the membership year or upon acceptance of application in full.

A Nine Hole Member shall enjoy affiliation with Golf Australia and associated State and area bodies.

A Nine Hole Member does not receive reciprocal rights with other Australia wide golf clubs.

Nine Hole Members are not permitted to play golf on weekends unless green fees are paid in full.

A Nine Hole Member is entitled to unrestricted access to the Club House facilities, and to the golf course and the Club facilities, except as restricted by this sub-rule.
